Allegro scherzato

Measures 1-4 of the piece. The right hand features a complex rhythmic pattern with slurs and fingerings (5, 4, 4, 2, 2, 1). The left hand plays a simple accompaniment of quarter notes. The tempo/mood is *p dolce e leggiero*.

Measures 5-8. The right hand continues with slurred eighth notes and includes a triplet. The left hand accompaniment remains consistent.

Measures 9-12. Measures 9-11 feature a series of slurred eighth notes with fingerings (5, 4, 2). Measure 12 introduces a new rhythmic pattern with slurs and fingerings (1, 2, 2, 3, 3, 5).

Measures 13-16. Measures 13-15 continue with slurred eighth notes and various fingerings (2, 5, 2, 4, 1, 3, 2, 4, 2, 4, 1, 2). Measure 16 concludes the piece with a final slurred eighth note and a fermata.
